Alluring eyes, razorlike fangs and pale skin - yes, vampires are what many will transform themselves into this All Hallows Eve.


Thanks to the successes of Stephenie Meyer's Twilight, HBO's True Blood and now The CW's Vampire Diaries, a show about a high-school girl torn between two vampire brothers, it's no wonder fangs are the way to go.

"Everyone wants to be a sexy vampire," says Na-thalie Bechard, Sephora pro beauty team member. "For Halloween, what's been the number one requested look so far has definitely been vampire, which I think has a lot to do with what we're seeing in the movies like Twilight."

MAC senior artist John Stapleton agrees we'll be seeing many of these sinister creatures walking among us on Halloween.

"People are going dark, but not necessarily scary. With vampires being the big trend, men and women want to be sexy vampires, not scary," Stapleton savs.

To achieve this look,



Stapleton says first apply a foundation or powder four shades lighter than your skin tone.

Sculpt your cheeks with a brown shadow to appear gaunt, and apply the same shadow thickly around your eyes to get that "haven't slept well in 3,000 years' look."

Line the inside of the eyes with a black pencil and dab red lip colour to the corners of your mouth.

"Plastic fangs, done," adds Stapleton.

Other popular requests include zombies, fairies, Marie Antoinette, Lady Gaga and Cleopatra, Bechard says.
